isgruntled 5 colleges and sports fans have been complaining about the Bowl Championship Series for years. It dictates the only path to a national champi-onship and the spoils that go with it. And a very narrow path it is, heavily favoring the traditional football powers of the Big Ten, BigEast, Pac-10 SEC, ACC and Big 12as well as Notre Dame. For everyone else,

it provides, at best, a long shot at one of the premier BCS bowls, and far more likely, a spot in one of the countless secondary bowls that continue to sprout up across the country.

The call for change has gotten even stronger since President Obama weighed in. Congressional hearings have been held. Bills have been introduced. Even the Department of d aon
